

**Ordinance establishing split shifts for election officials.**


The Town Board of Town of Eau Galle, Dunn County, Wisconsin, has specific authority under s.7.301(1), Wis, Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for selection of 2 (or more) sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:


A. There shall be 2 shifts for the Chief election inspector and 2 or 4 shifts for election inspectors on all election days *as needed*. For the Chief election inspector, the first shift shall commence at 6:30 am and end at 1:00 pm *if needed*. The second shift shall commence at 1:00 pm and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls. For the election inspectors the shifts are to be served between the hours of 6:30 am and end at 1:00 pm and second shift 1:00 pm to closure of polls *as needed*.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.


